Language P1 Q5 (writing)

What does the exam look like? Choice of 2 questions, one based on a picture stimulus, one on a given written starting point. The purpose of writing is to narrate and/or describe.

How is the exam marked? The response is marked out of 40, with 24 marks available for *subject content and organisation* (communicating effectively and imaginatively, adapting tone and style for a purpose) and 16 marks for *technical accuracy* (sentence, punctuation and vocabulary use).

How to revise. Plan responses, based on a picture or written stimulus. Make sure you focus on including a variety of sentence structure, punctuation and vocabulary. Try to include specific language techniques, such as alliteration, personification etc. Maybe even make a 'checklist' of things to include. Online helpful resources are Mr Bruff's YouTube channel and BBC Bitesize.
