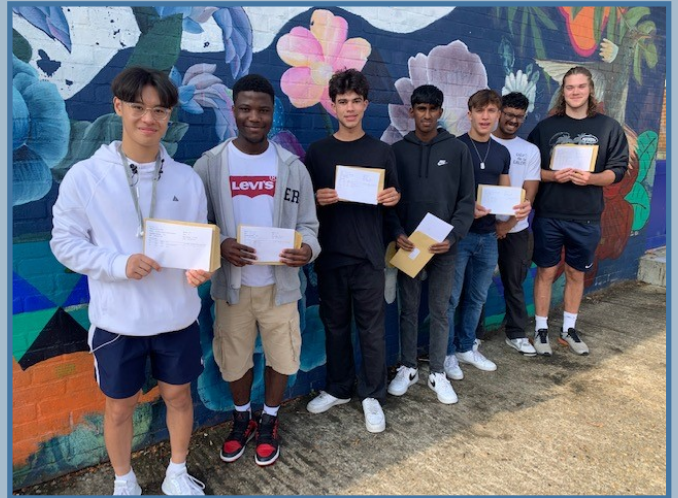


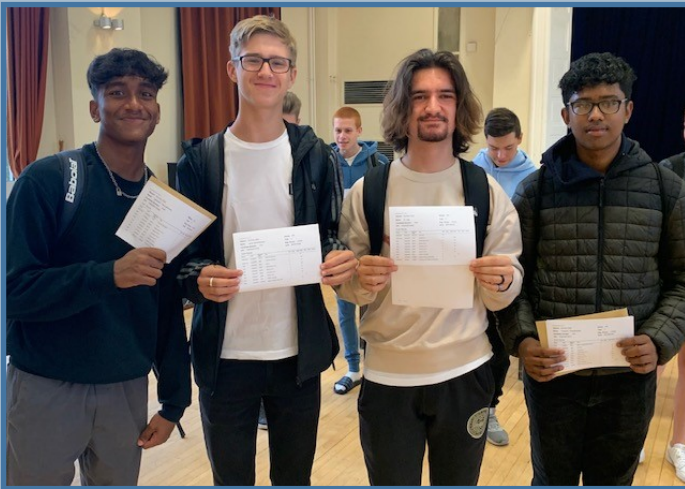


GCSE and A-Level Results 2022

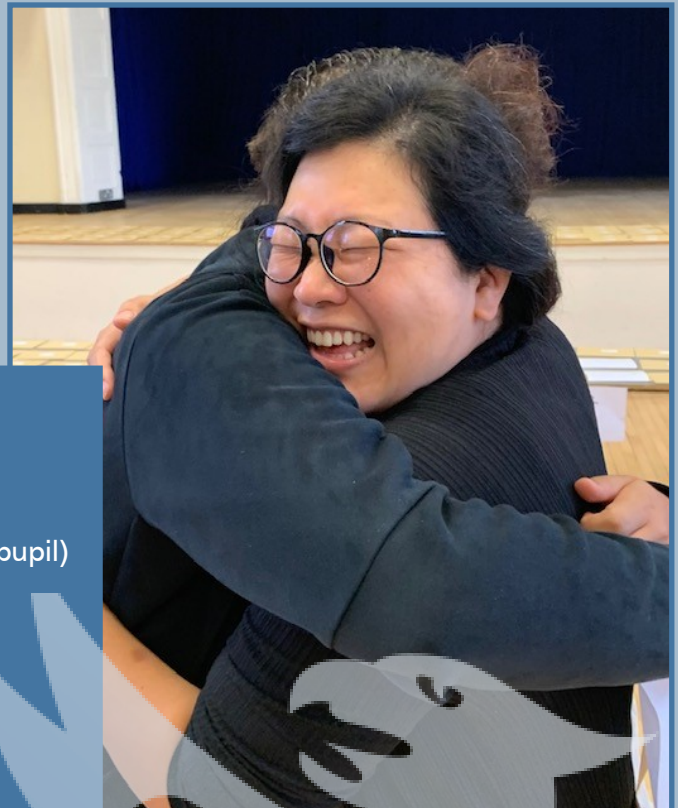
