As a consequence, we offer a range of different courses and levels to uniquely match the strengths and interests of almost all our students once they have completed their GCSE exams. We also offer a range of GCSE level 2 subjects for those students who perhaps require a little more time for a particular subject to 'fall into place'. For these students, we offer a year's 'breathing space' to grow and mature in a safe and happy environment before they then choose to take up Level 3 subjects or move to college, an apprenticeship or full time employment.

On Tuesday 10 August, students came into school to receive their A level/ Level 3 results and find out if they had got the grades they needed to secure their university places. Despite public exams being cancelled due to Covid, every student had worked their hardest, taking a wide and challenging range of internally assessed exams which were carefully marked, moderated and submitted to the exam boards by their dedicated teachers.

As you can see by the photos, our students were absolutely thrilled with their results and over 90% secured their first choice place at University. In addition to this, we feel particularly proud of the diversity of subjects that our students will be studying, from History & Politics, Biochemistry, Forensic Investigation, Nursing and Optometry to Actuarial Science, Film & Screen Studies, Aerospace Engineering and Computer Science.
