Pre Building Schools for the Future (BSF)

Last week we received confirmation from the LA that we have been successful in our bid to secure some much needed capital investment on our site pre- BSF. All Parents will be aware that full BSF is likely to take some time before it yields any positive outcomes in terms of our own school buildings. There is however, of course, an immediate need for investment if our current students are to benefit from improved provision. Over the last few weeks we have been making this case with the LA and it is this that has been successful. The amount of money allocated by the LA for some immediate improvement work is £400,000. Whilst this will not enable us to undertake major building works such as a new sports hall or refurbishment of the gyms, it does provide us with money to address some other significant needs. During the next couple of weeks we will be finalising plans for this improvement work.
